I am happy to let you know that the Annual ICVP-Technical Session (AITS) is scheduled on 7.11.2019 during the Veterinary Pathology Congress-2019, at the Central Agricultural University, Selesih, Aizawl, Mizoram from 14.30 to 17.00. The **Open Award Session (OAS)** shall be held for **ICVP Trainees and Young Veterinary Pathologist** including MVSc/PhD Students (**below or equal to 35 years of age and Life Member/Associate Member of IAVP**) on case presentations (focused on description of gross and microscopic lesions and complete PM reports as per the ICVP-format). Please refer the guidelines for case presentation for the award at www.icvp.in. The abstracts of case presentation shall be published in the compendium of Veterinary Pathology Congress – 2019. Please see below the important instructions for the submission of abstracts for Open Award Session of AITS-2019:

Important Instructions for abstract submission (THE DEADLINE FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION IS 21st September, 2019):

1. Clinical case should be original and has to be prepared under the guidance of Certified Pathologists (ICVP/ECVP/ACVP or equivalent) strictly following the pattern as described above.
2. An undertaking has to be submitted (as per the enclosed proforma) by the corresponding author regarding the originality of the case.
3. The presentation author must be the first author and the Certified Pathologist should be the corresponding author. In case of non-availability of certified pathologist, Head of the Department/Institute must be the corresponding author.
4. A presenting author can join as a co-author of more than one case report but only the first author-case report will be considered for the award.
5. For submission of abstract under ICVP Technical Session: Please visit www.icvp.in and follow the instructions for abstract submission.
6. Abstract submitted shall be reviewed by a committee, as constituted by the President, ICVP, for shortlisting the case reports for the award session.
7. ICVP reserve the rights to use the presented material for ICVP Board Certification Examination.
