The constitutional provisions of ICVP Training towards eligibility for ICVP Board Certification Examination:

Clause 13 B. Eligibility of the candidate:

The following general prerequisites must be met to the satisfaction of the College before any candidate is eligible to undertake certification examination in Veterinary Pathology.

- a) The candidate should be a Graduate in Veterinary Sciences and registered with the Veterinary Council of India.
- b) Has maintained a membership status, as Life Member of IAVP, by virtue of specialization (Master or Ph.D.) in the subject of Veterinary Pathology.
- c) Has completed at least three calendar years of supervised training after Master in Veterinary Pathology that is acceptable to the College. Normally, the acceptable supervised training is under the supervision & direction of Diplomate of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists as given in the application. The training may be conducted simultaneously with MVSc or Ph. D. program in Veterinary Pathology.
- d) Alternatively, the candidate must have 'Three years' full time exposure/experience in Veterinary Pathology (after acquiring post-graduate qualification), including a minimum period of one calendar year of training under the supervision of a Diplomate of the Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists.

Note: Beginning 2021 ICVP Board certification exam, the eligibility is only after one or three years of training.
