This is an open award Session, which is co-ordinated and conducted by all available Executive Council of ICVP, for young Vet Pathologist including MVSc/PhD Students (below 30 years of age and Life Member/Associate Member of IAVP and ASVP) on case presentations (focused on description of gross and microscopic lesions and complete PM reports). There shall be two awards:

1. ICVP President's Award for the first best case presentation (A certificate and Rs. 5000/- cash)
2. ICVP Secretary's Award for the second best case presentation (A certificate and Rs. 2,500/- cash)

Case presentations should focus on any of the following areas:

Farm animal pathology, Companion animal pathology, Avian pathology, Pathology of laboratory animals, pack animal pathology, wild animal pathology, Toxicological pathology.

(For the open award session, ICVP Diplomates are requested to prepare young and trainee-pathologists/postgraduate students for the case presentation. Abstract will be accepted only on recommendation of a ICVP Diplomat or a Executive Councillor of ASVP to the effect that the descriptions conforms to the lesion-description norms published by the ICVP or an equivalent overseas veterinary pathology certification agency like ACVP, ECVP JSPC etc)
