ICVP Board Certification Examination - 2022

The Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists was established at IVRI Izatnagar in 2008 by the Indian Association of Veterinary Pathologists for peer accreditation of Veterinary Pathologists practicing in India. The College admits members through an examination system which identifies Veterinary Pathologists with sufficient competence as per the standards and guidelines set by the college. Certified candidates will be awarded Diploma of the ICVP and will be eligible for membership status of the college through application with an appropriate fee and designated as **Diplomate of ICVP**.

The examination is conducted once every year, usually in September on the second Saturday and the following Sunday at a pre announced venue. **This year the examination has been scheduled on September 10-11, 2022 at Department of Veterinary Pathology, Nagpur Veterinary College, Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Seminary Hills, Nagpur- 440006 (Maharashtra).**

The Certification examination is normally restricted to VCI registered Veterinarians practicing in India/Overseas and who are trained/ recommended by a Diplomate or a Charter Member of the College. The training period is three years but relaxation in training period to one year is allowed for those (Veterinary Pathologists) who have experience and demonstrated the same in their field of practice. **Registration for ICVP training is open throughout the year.** Kindly visit the college website www.icvp.in for detailed guidelines including the eligibility criteria, syllabus, examination format, fee structure, etc.

The Indian College of Veterinary Pathologists invites application in the prescribed format from eligible candidates for the above examination which can be downloaded from the website www.icvp.in
