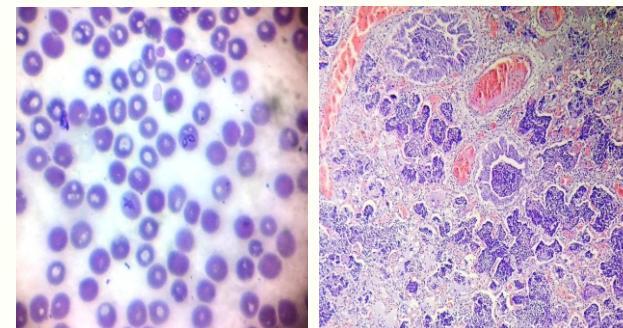

The department has well equipped laboratories consisting of automated haematology, histopathology and molecular biology labs and has completed more than 10 agency funded research projects. Faculty and students are actively involved in need based research and clinicopathological diagnostic services to field veterinarians, dairy and poultry sector, pharma industry and research institutes. Field applicable trainings are also conducted for livestock farmers and field veterinarians.

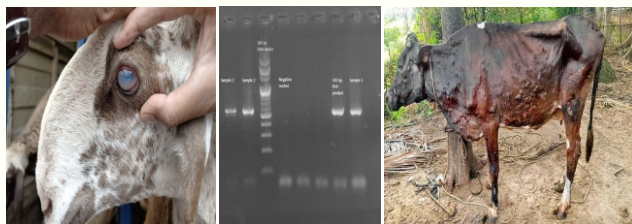
Submission of Research Abstracts & Posters
